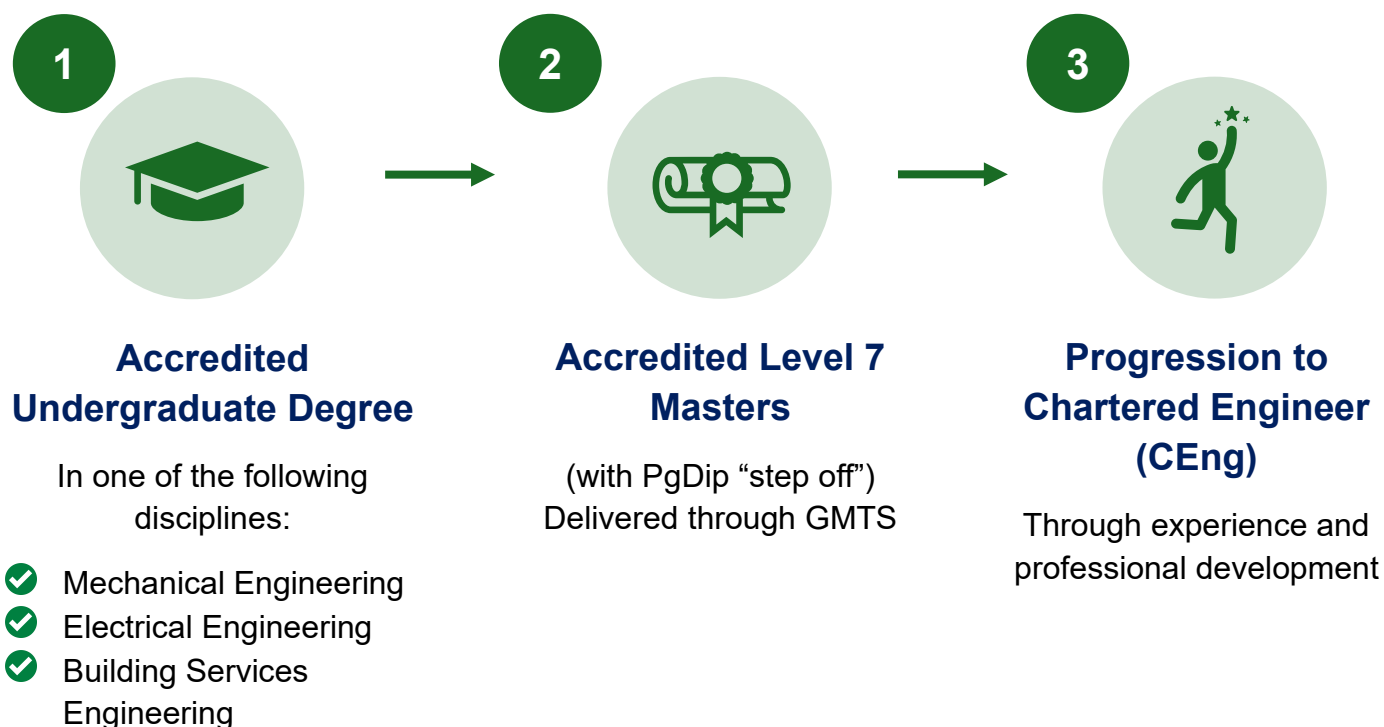

1 Eligibility Criteria

To join the GMTS Engineering and Estates specialism your undergraduate degree must be:

Accredited by a recognised professional body and in one of the following disciplines:

- ✓ Mechanical Engineering
- ✓ Electrical Engineering
- ✓ Building Services Engineering



If your degree is not accredited in one of the above disciplines, you may not be eligible
